


5. Analysis of walkingways

Analysis (1 hour of counting and watching people moving around the cortyards)




- High number of people moving across the cort-yards

 - Meeting points in 6 and




- More people moving vertically




Colour

Lighting


should make the paths feel more open and promote safety



Indications


to highlight the path systems and create differentiated passages


Moving shrubs

- blocked view to the building (coutryside feeling)






Rethink Lawn

- flowering meadow creates countryside feeling




Reconstruct Tree lines

Reconstruct the tree lines, realise the originaly intendet guiding of trees alongside of paths






9. Mixed Use

New needed communal spaces and infrastructure elements




- The cortyards at the moment don't have real functions that are in the original plans
